The proposal is submitted using the attached signed and dated form package

The procedure for awarding the MEDAILLE D'HONNEUR DU VOLONTARIAT ET DU BENEVOLAT EN EUROPE presented at the AVE consists of 5 steps:

- 1 – The constitution of the application file by the applicants : www.ave-europe.org
- 2 – The AVE office's submission of the application to the Trial Board for the award of the medal. The award decision shall be taken unanimously.
- 3 – The notification by the AVE office of the awarding of the medal to the applicants who will pay the rights of realization of the medal and of printing of the diploma corresponding to the costs of instruction and realization (50 € in 2022) and of the contribution of 25 € in 2020
- 4 - Notification by AVE Office to Medal Recipient
- 5 – The formal presentation of the medal by the designated AVE member at the COING meeting and/or at the specified time with the recipient and the applicants (The award of the medal may be made several times thereafter by any person holding the same medal or an authority after agreement of the AVE, with the aim of valuing the action of the recipient and the NGOs or INGOs within which it has worked.)

The applicants undertake to publish the award of the medal in associative publications and to communicate in the press and media of the countries of engagement of the recipient.

WITHDRAWAL OF THE MEDAL OF HONOUR FOR VOLUNTEERING IN EUROPE.

the commission of inquiry of the application for the award of the medal may withdraw this medal in the event of false declaration, discovery of crime or offence carried out by the recipient during his associative journey, to the facts and judgments. The decision to withdraw shall be taken unanimously.
